CSF Celebrates its 35th Anniversary and is Stronger than Ever

The life expectancy of a charitable nonprofit is dismally short and "the seeds of failure often begin before the nonprofit opens its doors." *Crain's, July 12, 2024, Marcus Baram.*

Instead, CSF's success was its formation by a few dedicated Croatians with a single objective, i.e., education of academically gifted and in financial need Croatian university students.

Also, those few Croatians in CSF leadership each had the required mix of intelligence, organizational skills, knowledge of community, connections and drive to set up the model which is followed today. It is remarkable that as the individuals changed, the model for success never deviated.

What is amazing is the forethought of CSF's founders in creating an organization which would appeal to, and as such, be supported by the Croatian community. For 35 years, CSF has had an all-volunteer board which strove to honor and acknowledge the work of our students without personal reward or aggrandizement. The succeeding leadership has the same exceptional abilities and organizational skills allowing for the monumental increase in the number of students, sponsors, endowments, and programs. All of course, without changing its singular objective; to provide educational opportunities for Croatian students which would not otherwise be available to them.

The CSF program continues on successfully. This year we were able to accept 40 new students and currently there are a total of 145 students receiving scholarships, which is a record number. It is important to note that accepted students receive scholarships for the duration of time they are at the university, three years of undergraduate, and two years of graduate studies.
